

CBAM is closing the green-steel price gap. It is not building the **plant that closes the carbon gap.**

A carbon cost on conventional steel makes clean steel competitive on price. Financing the capacity to make it is a value-chain problem — and that is where insetting fits.

CBAM's carbon cost on conventional steel now rivals the green-steel premium.

SO WHAT – FOR STEEL BUYERS

As CBAM phases in, conventional steel stops being the cheap option. **The price gap that made green steel look expensive is closing** — the barrier left is building the capacity, not the premium.

Price convergence doesn't build plants — producer and buyer each wait for the other.

THE OFFTAKE-CLAIM DEADLOCK — FRAMEWORK, ILLUSTRATIVE

SO WHAT — FOR THE VALUE CHAIN

Producers need offtake to finance green capacity; buyers need a claimable reduction to pay for it. **Insetting is the instrument that lets buyers co-fund the plant and claim the verified cut**, breaking the deadlock.

Three moves turn a closing price gap into built green-steel capacity.

1

STEEL BUYERS

Co-fund verified green-steel capacity and take an **allocated share of the reduction** as a Scope 3 claim — without needing physical delivery of that specific steel.

2

PRODUCERS

Convert a verified reduction into an **inset credit backed by forward demand** — the offtake certainty that lets the plant reach FID.

3

THE CHAIN

Use the CBAM embedded-emissions MRV as the shared baseline, then **allocate and trade the reduction** across the buyers that fund it.
